Artists, Commercial 2:30 to 3:00 P.M.

Assistant Personnel Directors early afternoon

Attorneys before 10:00 a.m. and after 4:00 p.m.
Auditors (CPA's) between 12th and 20th of month

Bankers before 10:00 A.M.

Brokers before stock market opens

Builders late afternoon on the job or 7:30 A.M.

Chemists late afternoon
Clergy mid week
Commission Merchants after 2:30 P.M.
Convalescent Homes 1:00 to 3:00 P.M.
Dairy Superintendents late afternoon

Dentists (check for days off) prior to 10:00 A.M.

Department Stores 8:30 to 9:30 A.M.
Dieticians 1:00 to 3:00 P.M.
Doctors (check for days of

Druggists 1:00 to 4:00 P.M.

Executives between 10:30 and 3:00 p.m.

Movers from 4th to 8th of month or 17th to 22nd of month — avoid Monday

Personnel Directors early to mid morning

Photographers mid morning
Printers after 4:00 p.m.
Publishers after 4:00 p.m.

Purchasing Agents first thing in morning — avoid Monday and Friday

Real Estate Agents mid morning, mid week
Retail Store Managers half hour before opening

Surgeons mid afternoon
Traffic People 1:00 to 3:00 p.m.

Wholesalers before 10:00 a.m. or Saturday morning
